A dynamic workshop will be held in Imperial Tuesday, Nov. 10, that is geared to develop the skills of individuals who will be giving presentations.

The SCORE workshop will be a great learning tool for anyone who gives presentations, whether it be for their business (owner or employee), an organization or even teachers, said Leslie Carlholm, the city of Imperial's Community Development Director.

SCORE stands for Super Closers, Openers, Review techniques and Energizers.
