

"Relentless" is a free youth conference coming to Imperial later this month on Nov. 21-22.

Coordinated by three Imperial churches and youth groups, the conference will also feature Sean Dunn from Groundwire as speaker and music by the Resistance band from Scottsbluff.

The weekend kicks off at 7 p.m. Saturday, Nov. 21, with worship featuring Resistance at Christian Faith Outreach (CFO), followed by speaker Sean Dunn. That will be followed by a dessert bar and fellowship time.

On Sunday, Nov. 22, there will be a service at 10:30 a.m. at CFO. From 1:30 to 4 p.m., youths will gather for an afternoon of fun at the old hotel at 5th and Broadway Sts.

At 7 p.m. Sunday, the group will return to CFO for an evening service, followed by ice cream and fellowship.

All sessions are open to the public, but are designed for junior high and high school students, according to organizers.
