Workers with Simon Contractors of North Platte were here Monday morning to begin the repair process at Imperial's swimming pool.

A section approximately five by seven feet was cut out from the concrete floor's southeast corner in the pool's deepest section.

It had been determined that the 12-inch main drain pipe underneath that city officials suspected was the site of the slow leak, said Public Works Supt. Pat Davison.

The contractor has ordered a sleeve that will be slid over the outside of the leaking pipe section and then bolted down and around, Davison said. It's not an item the contractor keeps on hand, he said, so they are waiting for the parts to arrive.
