

Sue Moore, an eight-year Imperial city council member, is one of the new directors on the executive board of the League of Nebraska Municipalities.

Her election came at the League's 2012 annual conference in Kearney Sept. 19-21.

Moore, who is seeking a third term on the city council in the November election, will serve with mayors and other city officials from across Nebraska on the 15-member executive board.

She's been on the League's Association of Risk Management (LARM) committee the past three years.
