One month after construction began, the Imperial Manor dining room's new look was shown off. Manor Director Melissa Larson said the \$25,000 renovation project went smoothly and was completed for the Feb. 14 target date.

Manor employees replaced everything except the floor. The walls were dry walled, painted and had faux rocks attached to the bottom of the walls to simulate a "mountain resort-type theme," Larson said.
