In the JV match Oct. 23, Chase County won in two, 25-21 and 25-11.

The JVs tallied 14 kills and seven hitting errors for a .130 hitting efficiency. Makala Bartels led at the net with six kills.

On serves, the team was 45-49 for 91 percent. Emma Bauerle had four of the team's 12 ace serves.
