The recognition comes for a student's involvement in athletics and other extra-curricular activities sponsored in high schools by the NSAA.

Students are nominated by their high schools, but must first meet the following criteria:

A nominated student must be a varsity player or organizational leader who has played a significant role on the team or in the organization's activity during the fall season.

The nominee must have a minimum cumulative grade point average in all subjects of 93 percent or A (3.7 on a 4.0 scale).

Two students can be nominated for each NSAA-sponsored activity.
