It was a topsy-turvy end to the Little League boys' baseball season the past week.

In first round games last Wednesday night, the top two seeded teams, Red and Orange, were defeated by the No. 3 and 4 seeded teams—Gold and Blue.

In Monday's finals, the No. 4 seeded Blue team came out on top to win the 2013 tourney championship, defeating No. 3 seeded Gold by a 18-13 score.

In Monday's consolation game, No. 2 seed Orange claimed third place with a 14-7 win over the tournament's top-seeded Red team.
