



Improvements are underway at the Southwest Nebraska Solid Waste Agency recycling center on East Highway 6 in Imperial. Workers took advantage of cooperative weather lately to pour a new approach at the south end of the building, above, at which area residents can drop off recyclables. City Public Works Supt.
