

The Nebraska Community Foundation (NCF) has named two new staff members to serve as affiliated fund development coordinators.

Serving the southwest Nebraska area as affiliated fund development coordinator is Karl Shaddock, a native of McCook.

Shaddock will support the development of NCF-affiliated funds in southwest Nebraska and perform administrative and development functions for the McCook Community Foundation Fund (MCOFF).
