

The Mid-Plains Center for Enterprise will offer a “Beginners CDL—Guide to the Written Exams” two-day workshop from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. on June 22-23 at the Mid-Plains Community College Extended Campus in Imperial.

This is an instructional workshop to give persons wanting to obtain a Commercial Drivers License (CDL) a comprehensive overview of the testing procedures, CDL materials, study guides and practice testing sessions.

After finishing this workshop, the student, with some outside study time, will have the knowledge and confidence to pass the State of Nebraska written CDL exams.

This workshop does not include any instruction in the driving skills. The student would be expected to get this experience on their own.

Course Instructor Mike Hall of Central Community College (CCC) and the CCC Commercial Truck Driver training staff have more than 140 combined years of experience in the trucking industry.

CCC is a certified CDL Third Party Tester, and all trainers are Certified Third Party Examiners with the Nebraska Department of Motor Vehicles.

Cost for the workshop is \$84.50.
