

Students at Chase County Schools wanting to take driver's education this summer have two session choices in June for the classroom instruction, either June 5-14 or June 17-26.

Registration for driver's ed. must be received by May 17. Cost is \$150 for CCS students, and is due no later than May 24 to the superintendent's office.
